- Experience with a dialect of SQL.
- Using the JDK and creating the necessary environment for compilation and execution of a Java executable from the command line.

Experience with or knowledge of JNDI, and JDBC. Entity EJB2.1, or EJB3.0 is not required but, is helpful. Please note that for people new to Hibernate, the Hibernate Essentials class is recommended before attending the Advanced Hibernate course.
