I. CICS Overview

This module describes transaction processing within CICS; how is a transaction triggered, the various CICS components involved, the main CICS resources that are needed in order to make this process happen are all subjects covered by this module.

II. CICS Resource

This chapter discusses CICS-managed resources and system files.

III. CICS Storage

This module discusses storage management in CICS, the various page pools (DSA's), the storage protection facility and transaction isolation.

IV. CICS Communication

This module discusses the various communications facilities available in CICS. MRO, ISC, DEC support, WEB interface, 320 bridge are all introduced here in an attempt to provide a total picture of what CICS can do.

V. Online tools

This chapter introduces the system programmer to the various online tools available in CICS. CEMT, CECI, CMAC, CEDF, CEDX are just a few of the transactions discussed in this chapter.

VI. CICS Offline Utilities

An overview of CICS utilities will be presented focusing on trace and the resource definition utility program. Time will also be spent on some CICS on-line utilities like CETR, CEDF, CIND and more.

VII. Specialized Functions

This module provides an overview of some of the most important functions provided by CICS. Components that are covered are Recovery & Log Managers, Business Transaction Services, Open transaction Environment, VSAM/RLS, Named Counters, CICS Web Services, Java and J2EE support and more.
