Description

Workload Automation AE r11.3.6 (Workload Automation AE) simplifies the delivery, availability, and performance of complex cross-platform workloads and schedules enterprise-wide.

Through hands-on exercises, this course will teach you how to confirm prerequisite installation, install Workload Control Center r11.4 SP3 (WCC), and install Workload Automation AE. You will also verify installation and perform configuration activities. Finally, you will learn how to locate, download, and apply patches and service packs to maintain the optimal operation of your Workload Automation AE system.
