This course teaches experienced system administrators the skills required to implement, administer, and maintain an IBM FileNet P8 4.0 Business Process Manager system.

Objectives

- Create BPM infrastructure including isolated region, queues, rosters, and event logs
- Customize BPM structures and integrate process components
- Perform BPM Web Services configuration
- Perform BPM system maintenance and administrative tasks
- Perform BPM system performance tuning

Topics

- Review P8 and BPM architecture and components
- Create isolated region, queues, rosters, and event logs
- Manage isolation region security
- Process Orchestration and Web Services configuration
- Integration with external systems via component steps
- Manage and maintain workflows in process
- Perform daily, weekly, and monthly administrative tasks
- Performance tuning

The course material assumes experience in system administration and working knowledge of FileNet P8 or completion of a P8 administration training course. The audience for this course should be technical in nature.
